

2 Quick Sources To Find Clarksville Area Burglaries

1. The Montgomery Sheriff Department website (www.mcsotn.org)

The advantage of this site is that it is comprehensive, including not only B&E's (breaking and enterings), but Alarm reports, home invasions, and other crimes which are often actually home invasions (for example, Rape, Shooting, etc.).

The disadvantage is that it only covers two days of reports (today's and yesterday's).

1. Hover your mouse pointer over "Public Inquiry".
2. Click on "911 Call Log".
3. Click on the date you want. Then look for B&E's, etc.

911 calls are logged by Military Time in the far left column.

2. The Clarksville Police Department-fed Crime Reports (www.crimereports.com)

It can be a little complicated, but is fascinating.

1. Type in "Clarksville, TN" in the "search" bar.
2. Put in a "Date Range" with the drop-down calendar (I like to look at 60 days at a time).
3. Uncheck everything but "Breaking and Entering" on the "Incident Layers".
4. Zoom in or out to see the city B&E's (there are 399 in the 2-month period preceding this writing for example, which is pretty typical).
